## POLICY ON MUSEUM PASS USAGE

- 1. Museum passes are available to all residents of Massachusetts. Museum Passes may be reserved in advance by Westford residents and by non-resident members of the Friends of the Library. Museum passes may be reserved and picked up by non-residents of Westford on the day of use.
- 2. Museum passes must be reserved and handled by an adult (18 years or older) family member. Patrons are responsible for keeping their library contact information up to date.
- 3. No more than two (2) museum passes may be used by a family at one time. The Library staff reserves the right to monitor usage to ensure fairness and access for the greatest number of patrons.
- 4. Patrons may reserve passes up to 60 days in advance.
- 5. Passes may be picked up the night before use, or the day of use.
- 6. All non-coupon passes must be returned to the Library <u>NO LATER THAN 7:00pm</u> of the day on which the pass is used. Should the library be closed, the pass may be dropped in the accompanying case into the front or rear book drops.
- 7. Any user who retains a pass two days beyond the due date (i.e. day of use), or loses a pass, will be charged via certified mail the replacement cost of that museum pass.
- 8. In the event that non-return of a pass necessitates the Library paying an entrance fee for the next user, that entry cost to the Museum will be assessed to the record of the negligent borrower.
- 9. Library Museum Passes are a service provided through the funding of the Friends of the J. V. Fletcher Library, Inc., Community and Civic Groups and the Board of Library Trustees.
