

POLICY ON STUDY ROOMS AND TUTORIALS

Designated Study spaces exist in the J. V. Fletcher Library to provide the most conducive environments for individual, group and tutorial study. Because of the library's open architecture and multi-age collections, the following areas are designated for study and silent study purposes:

STUDY ROOM

The Study Room off the Fine Arts area is designated for the following:

- literacy tutorials
- group or independent study
- test-taking

The Study Room is reserved on a repeat or first come, first served basis by booking time via the Meeting Room Coordinator.

SILENT STUDY AREA

The Veronica Whitehouse Memorial Silent Study Area on the mezzanine level is restricted to silent, serious study and research. Talking, group study and tutoring are prohibited in this space.

TUTORIALS

Tutorials may take place on study tables, computer bars and carrels and may not be conducted in lounge areas or on lounge seating within the library.

Patrons needing assistance in finding an appropriate study or tutorial venue are encouraged to see the Building Supervisor.
