# LIBRARY EXPANSION GRANT

In January 2022, waitlisted Grant libraries received notice that they might receive their grant notification one year early. Acting on this possibility, \$10,000 was requested in Capital Funds for cost estimating to be voted on at the June 2022 Annual Town Meeting. On May 6, 2022 the Commonwealth Executive Office of

Administration and Finance confirmed additional funds with the result that waitlisted libraries — including Westford -- received their grant notification one year early in July 2022. In order to present

accurate and timely cost estimates to Fall Town Meeting, a *Reserve Fund Transfer Request* of \$20,465 for cost estimating was submitted and we thank the Finance Committee for approving this request. These funds were supplemented with an expenditure from the *J. V. Fletcher Library Trust Fund* of \$24,836 and a match from the *Library State Aid* account in the amount of \$11,164. Town voters approved the Library Project enthusiastically at the Special Town Meeting October 17, 2022, with the following vote results - Yes: 436, No: 141 and at the November 8 Local Ballot with these vote

results Yes: 6620, No: 4212. The Board of Library Trustees thanks the Friends of the J. V. Fletcher Library for their incredible advocacy on behalf of Town Meeting and Ballot votes to support the Library Building Project and Grant, and to secure approval for this transformative community project.

# **TRUSTEE FY 2023 GOALS**

- I. Upon the awarding of a provisional grant notice from the Board of Library Commissioners, the Board of Library Trustees, Friends of the Library Board, Advocacy Committee and staff will work to secure two positive votes at Special Town Meeting and on the local ballot to approve the MPLCP grant prior to January 9, 2023.
- II. The Board of Library Trustees will collaborate with the Friends of the J. V. Fletcher Library, Inc. in launching the J. V. Fletcher Library Foundation to pursue fund raising on behalf of the Library Construction project.
- III. Board of Library Trustees liaisons and library staff will routinely meet and work with the Permanent Town Building Committee on Designer

Selection and Design Development to advance the Massachusetts Public Library Construction Project.

- IV. In keeping with the initiatives of the *Town and School Safety Task Force*, the Board of Library Trustees will pursue safety, security and mental health support measures in the areas of:
  - a. Policy
  - b. Procedure
  - c. Emergency Response
  - d. Mental Health collections and programs
- V. In keeping with the initiatives of the *Town Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committee*, the Board of Library Trustees will promote collection, display and programming initiatives which reflect the charge of this committee.
